Stormwater System Inventory

Public Works is starting a stormwater System Inventory project this month that is expected to last through July. This project will include assessing & measuring stormwater infrastructure including pipes, manholes, culverts, etc. WithersRavenel, an engineering firm, will be performing the audio for us, so you may see their crews & trucks (like the one at

right) on the roads. WithersRavenel staff will carefully assess this stormwater infrastructure using rights-of-way, easements & common areas as much as possible. We do not expect any major traffic impacts or street closures during this inventory project. For questions about the project,

Ages 5-12


