



2021-2022 COED VOLLEYBALL GENERAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This modified adult volleyball league is an organized, competitive program for ages 16 and older. The league includes 8 regular season games, and a postseason tournament. All games will take place on Monday nights at the West New Bern Recreation Center.

REGISTRATION

Registration for the Coed Volleyball league will end on November 19th.

The cost per player is \$35.00 for city residents and \$45.00 for non-residents. Team managers that want to register their team should collect payments, along with player registration forms and submit it all together. This fee is due no later than November 19th. This fee covers equipment, game officials, awards, and post season tournament.

Cash and Check are acceptable forms of payment in person. Online registration will accept credit cards. Note: There is a \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks. **Note: those who have outstanding balances or failure to return issued equipment from previous seasons will not be eligible to register until your account is in good standing.**

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA FOR PLAYER PARTICIPATION?

Each individual participant must complete a registration form and either join a team with approval from that team's manager or create their own team. If there are 6 or more participants that registered individually (not affiliated with a team), those participants will comprise a team. If there are less than 6 participants that registered individually, New Bern Parks & Recreation Staff will work with team managers to place players on a team. All teams must have a minimum of 6 players and a max of 12 players. Teams must have at least 3 female players. A player must be 16 years of age by November 1st, 2021, to be eligible to play.

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA FOR UNIFORMS?

Each team is responsible for providing their own uniforms. Uniforms should consist of matching shirt color with unduplicated numbers on the back. Uniforms are not mandatory and are at the discretion of the team manager.

WHEN WILL GAMES BEGIN?

Games are scheduled to begin Monday November 29th. All games are played on Mondays, beginning at 6pm with subsequent games to follow at 7pm and 8pm. Scheduled game dates are as follows: November 29th, December 6th, 13th, and 27th, January 3rd, 10th, 24th, and 31st, and February 7th. Schedules will be available online and will be emailed to team managers. Makeup games will be played on the earliest available day. Makeup games may require teams to play a double-header.

WHERE CAN I FIND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS?

All rules will be available online at our Parks and Recreation page at www.NewBernNC.gov. Rules are based on the National Federation of State High School (NFHS) Rules Book with the addition of applicable coed rules from the United States Volleyball Rules Book for rotation, contact play, and back row blocker and City League Rules or special boundary rules applicable to facility.

WHAT ARE THE GAME EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS?

New Bern Parks & Recreation will provide playing equipment and game balls. Warmup balls, or accessories such as knee pads will not be provided. It is recommended but not required for players to wear knee pads or other accessories.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Player seating area will be socially distanced 6 feet apart. Use of face mask is recommended but not required. Additional safety protocols that help minimize risk may be implemented at any time. The North Carolina Governor's Executive Order in place at the time of the activity and/or any guidelines established by the NCDHHS shall be followed.
